Below is a copy of our school bus rules. Please help us review bus safety by reading these rules with your child. Sign this paper with your child to reinforce the importance of school bus safety, and have him or her return this form to his or her teacher by August 14<sup>th</sup>.

1. Obey the bus driver.
2. Walk as you get on and off the bus. When exiting the bus do not walk behind the bus or on the driver's side of the bus.
3. Keep the aisles clear of books and bags.
4. Talk quietly to people near you.
5. Keep your hands and feet to yourself and no sticking heads or hands outside of the windows.
6. Stay in your assigned seat. No switching of seats while the bus is in motion.
7. Be aware of surroundings when exiting the bus. Use crosswalks or walk directly to parent's or guardian's parked cars.
8. No eating or drinking on the bus.
9. Toys are not allowed in school and on the bus.
10. Cellphones or other kinds of electronic devices are not to be used on the bus.

By following the rules above, your child will avoid receiving a bus referral by the busdriver. The school will contact parents or guardians regarding consequences. However, multiple referrals could lead to suspension from the bus.
